SAILING MARKS, &c.
 A. North Channel; Bugio and Sugar loaf Hill.
 B. Bugio and Southern part of Lisbon, nearly East by compass.
 C. The Barcarena or lookout House, well open to the northward of the Paps.
 D. E. Turning marks, as represented above.
 Note. A strong ebb tide, with a breeze from the Sea, make a break over the Bar, sometimes all over, and have frequently sheered vessels about. But, near mid channel, the tide sets directly through.
