



With the conquest of German East Africa, the British Imperial Forces, assisted by their French, Belgian and Portuguese Allies, have now completed their task of expelling Germany from the colonies which she has misgoverned too long. In the first map, the captured territories, which embrace an area of 1,032,280 square miles, are coloured thus . The extent of this area will be appreciated by a glance at the second map, in which the oblong block, similarly coloured, represents a square mileage equivalent to the total of the territory which Germany has lost in Africa.
