Gifted with a temperate climate and close to Lisbon are the fine Sunny Coast seaside resorts of Carcavelos, Parede, S. Pedro, S. João, Santo António do Estoril, Monte Estoril and Cascais, all of which are served by regular electric trains and main coastal road from where a beautiful view over the whole surrounding region may be gazzed out. Estoril, however, is the «lovely garden by the sea», and, above all, the most fashionable seaside resort for it includes excellent hotel organizations, casino, swimming-pools, golf courses, horse-racing and tennis-courts. Within easy stretch of Estoril lies the pretty bay of Cascais with its wonderful, small beach, busy fishing centre and

The well-known «Mouth of Hell» (Boca do Inferno) stands about 10 minutes from Cascais and the beach of Guincho is at a short distance, with extensive pinewoods and large sandy shore spotted by abrupt rock formations rising above a rough sea. It is here that lies the famous Roca Cape, or the westernmost point of the European

colourful boats, where sportsmen may always enjoy nautical

Guincho seaside resort has excellent hotel and restaurant organizations and includes a good bus service from the town of Carcavelos, via the «Mouth of Hell» (Boca do Inferno).



QUELUZ • SINTRA • ERICEIRA MAFRA . LISBOA

One of the touristic tours that may be had leads to Queluz, Sintra, Ericeira and Mafra, spots of which are at a short distance from each other and bear a different and The Palace of Queluz built by order of the Queen

D. Maria I and King D. Pedro III, dating back to the XVIIIth century and with the same architectural trends of the «Petit Trianon» in Versailles, is only 12 km away from Lisbon. The building is ascribed to the French architect Jean Baptiste Robillon and to the Portuguese Master Mateus Vicente and was during the XIXth century the favourite residence of the King D. João VI and of his wife Queen D. Carlota Joaquina. Worth mentioning are the «Ambassadors' Room», the «Music Room» and the «Royal Chamber». Not far away stands the beautiful mountain of Sintra, the highest point of which is 529 metres, at Cruz Alta. Its mild climate and fruitful soil gave rise to the planning of a wonderful area near the mountain summit so-called the «Pena Park». The garden was set by order of the King D. Fernando II, and is considered as one of the most pretty European spots. It is followed by the «Monserrate Park» shaped out by Sir Francis Cook. Yet, within the park, it may be noticed a beautiful

palace from where is seen a vast panorama. The primitive part of this building was erected by the King D. Manuel I from an old convent dating back to the XVIth century and destined to the monks of the Jerónimos Order. The recently constructed wing of the palace was latter built under the patronage of King D. Fernando II during the XIXth century

Near to the Palace of Pena stands the Moorish castle

conquered by the King D. Afonso Henriques. Located on the hillside of the Mountain of Sintra, lies the village of the same name, one of the oldest Portuguese towns, including a Royal Palace, which since the XVIth century was the favourite residence of the Portuguese Kings. This art work, built on the site of the old Moorish «Alcaçor», is mainly attributed to King D. João I (1385-1433) and to the King D. Manuel 1 (1495-1521). Within the old building are worth mentioning the magnificent tilework and the Arabs' Hall, both the rooms of the Mermaids and of

the Magpies, the Swans' Room, and the Hall of the Coats-

built during both the VIIth and IXth centuries and latter



Other monuments of no less artistic interest are the Palace of Seteais, Monserrate and the Capuchos Convent. On driving to Colares travellers may visit the Regional Wine Cellar (Adega Regional), and the pleasant seaside resorts of Praia Grande and of Praia das Maçãs, or, if wanted, by making a slight detour to Ericeira, appreciate amongst the many typical dishes the famed «Lobster Panada» (Açorda de Lagosta).

Further away lies the village of Mafra with its imposing Monastery and Royal Palace erected early XVIIIth century by the King D. João V in fulfilment of a vow when he feared his marriage left no descendency.

The building is laid out after the plans of the architect João Frederico Ludwig also known by the name of Ludovice Ratesbona. Final works took about thirteen years, and the whole structure occupies a total area of 40 000 square metres and includes a magnificent Library with 35 000 volumes. It is here that also existed the extraordinary school of sculpture headed by both the Italian architect Alexandre Guisti and the Master Machado de Castro. At the end of this visiting tour visitors should take the

Both the above mentioned itineraries are of surprising panoramic beauty as driving from Cacilhas to the village of Sesimbra, the traveller will find there not only the old Castle conquered to the Moors by the King D. Afonso Henriques but its important fishing port and very pretty beaches with

At about a quarter of an hour by motor-car (or 45 minutes motorcoach drive) stands the mountain and the Portinho da Arrábida, with a charming beach resort and bay tenderly However, the most wonderful sight may be had from one of the Serra da Arrábida belvederes, as it is here that the whole panorama is superb and reaches the city of Lisbon, Cascais and Sintra, and further extends over the

oposite surrounding area, where it may be noticed the river Sado, Tróia and the Atlantic Ocean. Leaving the mountain of Arrábida, travellers draw near to Setübal, main fishing port and important centre for canning industries. Yet within the town are the Castle of St. Philipe, dominating the village, the Church of Our Lord the Christ, all shaped out in Manueline style and the

Driving to Palmela on the way back to Cacilhas, one of Moscatel wines and may visit the historical castle conquered by the King D. Sancho I. A slight detour is to recommend when reaching the

town of Setúbal in order to visit Vila Franca de Xira, situated


