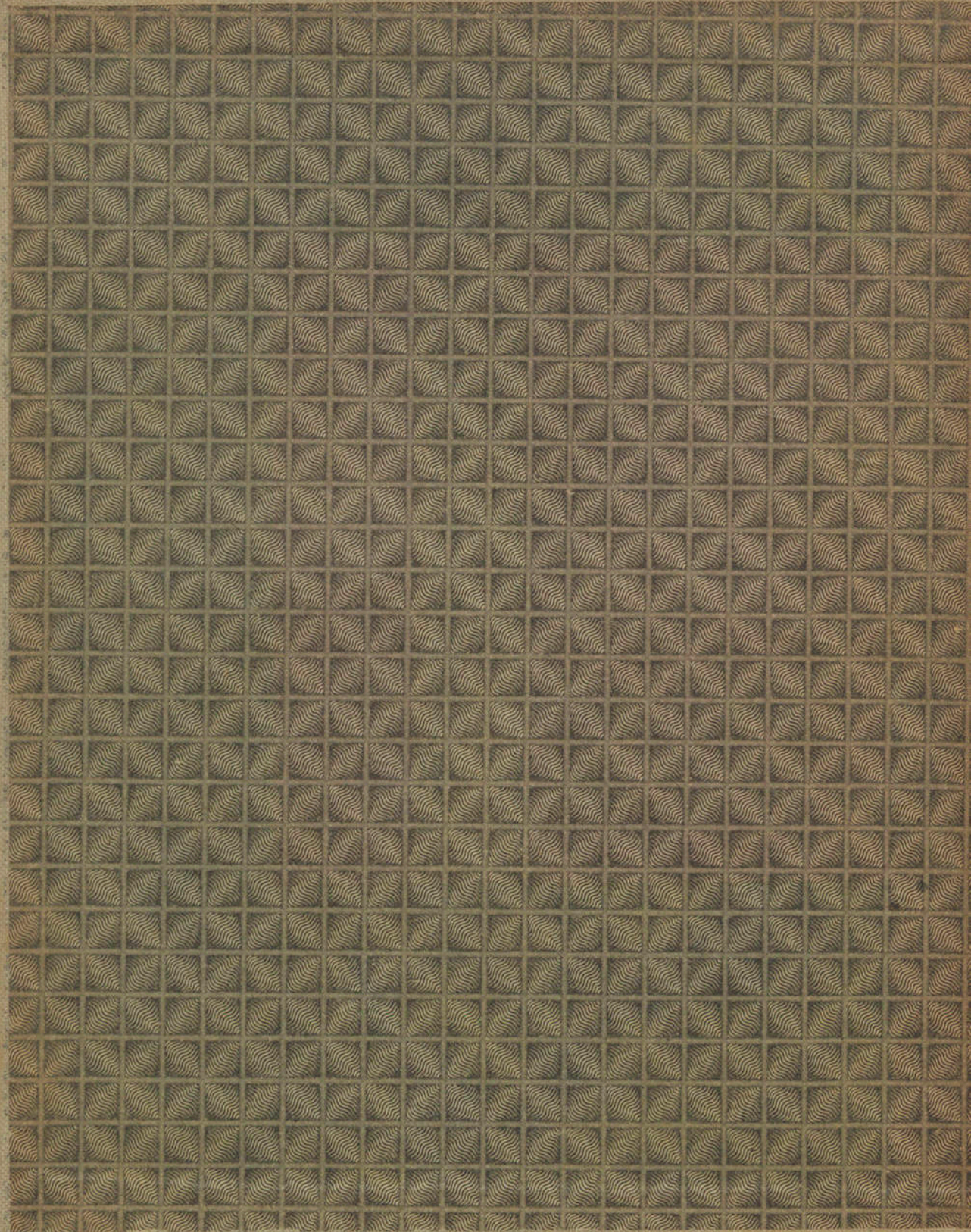

FRIDAY, the 16th

- 0515— Pilots board U. S. S. HOUSTON, LITTLE ROCK, FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT, CONE, WARRINGTON, PERRY, NOA and NEW outside bar.
- 0800— The Ships salute the country.
- 1000— The Commander of the Fleet calls on His Excellency the American Ambassador at his Residence.
- 1030— The Commander of the Fleet calls on the Major General of the Armada.
- 1045— The Commander of the Fleet accompanied by the American Ambassador, calls on the Minister of Marine.
- 1130— The Commander of the Fleet accompanied by the American Ambassador, calls on the Minister of Foreign Affairs at S. Bento Palace.
- 1230— The Commander of the Fleet accompanied by the American Ambassador, calls on His Excellency the President of the Republic.
- 1500— The Commander of the Fleet holds Press conference on board U. S. S. HOUSTON.
- 1600— The American Ambassador, the Major General of the Armada, to the Minister of Marine and the Minister of Foreign Affairs return
- 1730 calls on the Commander of the Fleet by sea.
- 2030— American Ambassador's dinner at the Embassy. The President of the Republic will attend.
- 2130— Party at the «Feira Popular» for American sailors.
- 2200— Supper dance for officers given by the American Ambassador at Aviz Hotel.

- 1200— His Excellency the President of the Republic visits U. S. S. HOUSTON by sea.
- 1400— The Minister of Foreign Affairs' luncheon for the Commander of the Fleet at Palácio da Pena, Sintra. Visit to the Pena Park and Palácio da Vila will follow.

2330— Party for officers at «Feira Popular» in Restaurant «California».

- 1000— Manouvers on board U. S. S. Airplane carrier FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT, with Commander of the 12th Fleet's luncheon for Naval and Civil authorities.

1600— Excursion via Azeitão and Arrábida followed by cocktail party at the Palmela Castle, offered by the Portuguese Navy to American officers.
1700— Portuguese Navy garden party, with dancing at Zoological Gardens, offered to the American sailors.
1730— Invitation to tea at Estoril Casino by Portuguese naval officers to American officers.

2000— The Commander of the 12th Fleet's dinner for the Minister of Marine on board U. S. S. HOUSTON.
2200— Dinner party offered by the American Embassy at Aviz Hotel.

2230— The President of Portugal's Festival at Queluz Palace, followed by supper.

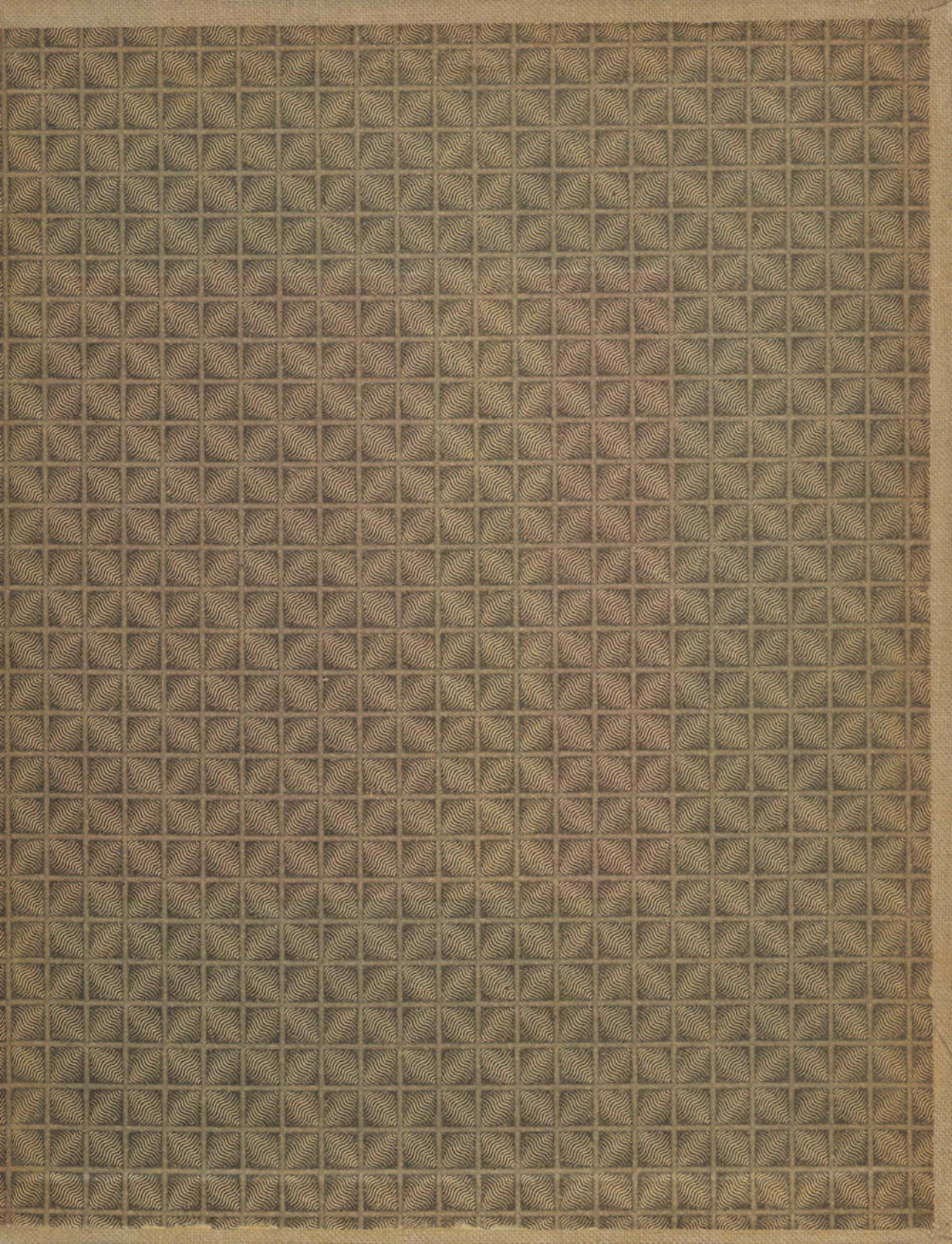
