



VIEW OF THE FORDING OF THE RIVER MONDEGO by the Allied Army on the 21st Sept., 1810.










NOTE TROOFS. BEVOLACIN'D NEAR THE VILLAGE OF VILLA.


A VIEW OF THE SHERRA DE BUSACO AT ST. ANTONIO DE CANTERRO,






