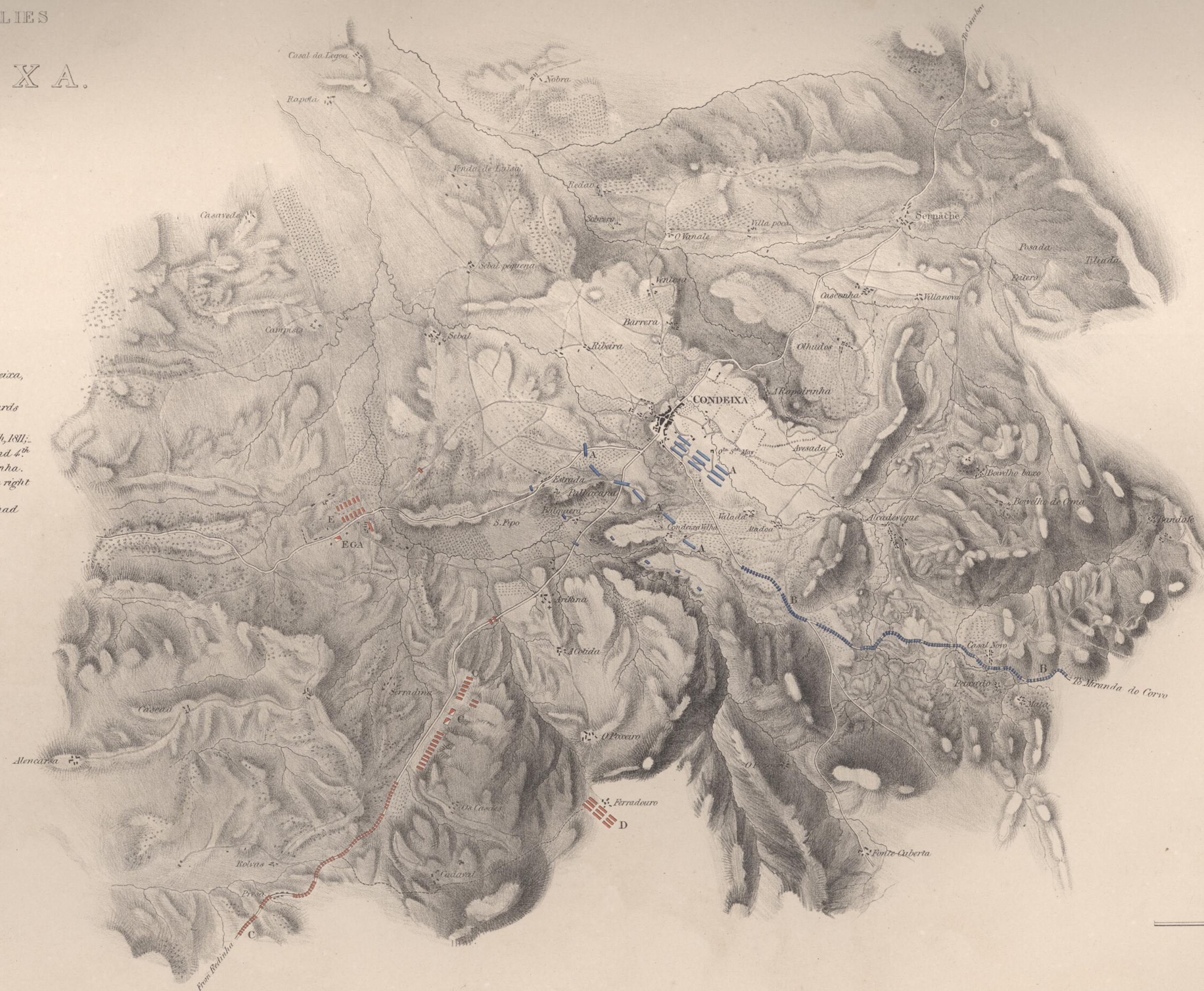


ADVANCE OF THE ALLIES
